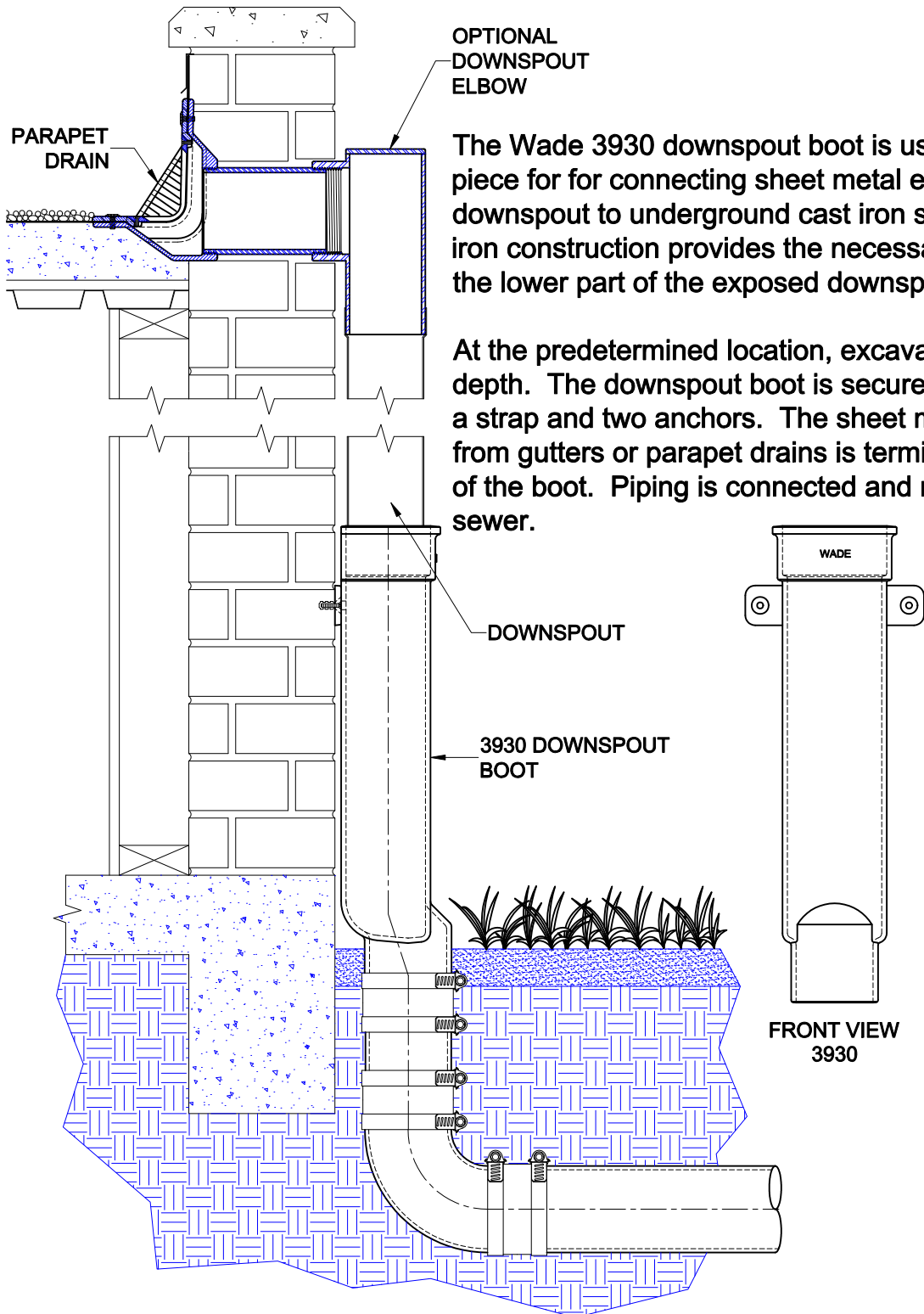


DOWNSPOUT BOOT

PAINTED CAST IRON DOWNSPOUT BOOT WITH 5x4 INLET, 4" NO-HUB OUTLET AND SECURING STRAP.

The Wade 3930 downspout boot is used as a transition piece for for connecting sheet metal exposed downspout to underground cast iron soil pipe. Cast iron construction provides the necessary protection for the lower part of the exposed downspout.

At the predetermined location, excavate to the desired depth. The downspout boot is secured to the wall with a strap and two anchors. The sheet metal downspout from gutters or parapet drains is terminated in the top of the boot. Piping is connected and run to the storm sewer.
